1. Summary of highlights of the last year for FOML

March-Dia De Los Ninos/Libros: donated \$1000 to buy books and supplies for 500 children

April-Clare Noonan named Shining Star by Stanislaus Library Foundation Modesto members raised \$143.71 eating at Unos Chicago Grill FOML painted the Modesto retaining wall

May- Used Book Sale made \$3200

Scholastic ½ Off New Books For Kids earned \$1100 and 376 books worth \$1193.56

June- Approved \$14,635 in Library requests for 2104/2014

Donated \$3000 to Save Stanislaus Libraries Hosted Sarah Stevenson's book launch

July-Donated \$200 for books given to children at the Stanislaus County Fair August-The Little Shop donated \$30 gift certificate to the Adult Summer Reading September: Children's Room painted with FOML funding

Sponsored Family Legacy Workshop

October: Halloween Parade party attended by 200+

Unos Chicago Grill fundraiser earned \$92 during National Friends of the Library Week

November: Scholastic Book Fair with Wish Lists to local youth agencies. Earned \$900 in cash, collected \$1395.92 worth of books for agencies and library and earned \$150 in credit and rewards
