February 10, 2020

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by President, Susan Guest, at 1:00 PM in the library conference room..

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Susan passed around a letter that she received from the Stanislaus County Office of Education asking for volunteers to judge History Day. No one expressed an interest in volunteering for this.

OLD BUSINESS: Scholarship donations were discussed. Donald Hess made a motion to give the P.R.I.D.E. scholarship fund \$600 for the Marilyn Allen Memorial Scholarship from the Patterson Friends of the Library. Motion was seconded by Trudy DeGroot and passed. Sue will write the check for \$600 and give it to the P.R.I.D.E. chairperson.

NEW BUSINESS: Donald showed us the book he has started for 2020 as Historian.
