April Events at the Ceres Library

This April, visitors to the Ceres Library can enjoy free crafts, activities, and a free show. Wee Move and Play will be held on Wednesdays, April 5 and 19 at 11:30 a.m. This program features

unstructured playtime for toddlers and preschoolers, during which they can enjoy movement and sensory play.

The library will host a LEGO Day on Thursday, April 6 at 3:30 p.m. Children will have the opportunity to build LEGO creations that will then be displayed in the library. Participants under the age of 4 must have direct parental supervision.

On Saturdays, April 8 and 22, between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. the library will offer a drop-in knitting program designed for beginning knitters, or individuals who would like to improve their knitting skills. Interested parties are encouraged to visit the library's circulation desk to get started. Needles and yarn will be available for beginning knitters.

The library will host two craft programs for children and teens this month, beginning with the "Build an Edible Peeps Birdhouse" craft on Thursday, April 13 at 3:30 p.m. Participants will build the birdhouses out of seasonal peeps and other treats. On Thursday, April 20 at 3:30 p.m. crafters can make their own kaleidoscopes out of recyclable materials. These crafts are sponsored by the Friends of the Ceres Library.

Families are invited to the free Act!vated Story Theatre program on Monday, April 24 at 3:30 p.m. The Goza family will perform two multicultural folk tales featuring physical comedy, music, song, dance, American Sign Language, and audience participation.
