Crafters looking for a more unstructured creative outlet will enjoy the Craft-a-Palooza on Thursday, Aug. 23 at 3:30 p.m. A variety of crafts and craft materials will be set out for children and teens to make and take home. This program is designed to encourage children to use their imaginations in order to make unique crafts.

Aspiring young artists can test their skills at the salt/glue painting program on Thursday, Aug. 30 at 3:30 p.m. Participants can try their hand at creating art using different types of materials. As this program may get messy, children are encouraged to dress accordingly.
