June Events at the Keyes Library

Children, teens and adults can take advantage of a variety of free programs at the Keyes Library this June, beginning with Preschool Story Time on Tuesdays at 10 a.m. Story Times feature new and classic picture books, flannel board and puppet stories, fingerplays, music and dancing, for preschoolers ages 3 to 5 and their caregivers, however all ages are welcome.

LEGO® Days will be held on Tuesdays, June 5 and 19 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Finished LEGO® creations will be displayed in the library. Children under the age of 4 must have direct parental supervision.

The library will host a drop-in craft stick bracelet program for all ages on Thursday, June 7 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Crafters will decorate bracelets using decorative washi tape and markers.

Children and their families can enjoy a free magic show featuring illusionist Timothy James on Tuesday, June 12 at 1 p.m. James' show blends magic and comedy together to create an upbeat experience.

Children can take part in a STEAM* lava lamp activity on Thursday, June 14 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. (*Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) Participants will use bright neon colors, oil and water to create colorful lava lamps.

All ages are invited to make window clings on Thursday, June 21 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. The library will provide glue and food coloring to use in making the window clings. Completed window clings may be taken home and used to decorate car or house windows.

On Friday, June 22, adults and teens drop in to enjoy a pom-prom craft from 9 a.m. to 4:30 -- MORE--

p.m. Participants will learn how to make decorative pom-poms using yarn and forks.

All ages can take part in a straw rocket craft on Thursday, June 28 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Throughout the day, the library will provide straws, neon tape, and foam pieces for crafters to use to make their rockets. Participants can then take their rockets outside to test them out.
