The Modesto Library will offer free programs for all ages this April, beginning with LEGO days on Mondays at 3:30 p.m. Participants are invited to build LEGO creations, which will be placed on display in the library for one week. Duplo blocks will be available for children under the age of 4, however they must have direct parental supervision.

Community members can take advantage of free computer classes at the library this month. Internet Basics will be held on Thursday, April 7 at 1:30 p.m. Excel Intermediate, a continuation of Excel Basics, will take place on Tuesday, April 19 at 6 p.m. Email Basics will be offered on Thursday, April 21 at 1:30 p.m. Email Basics participants will need to create an email account prior to the beginning of the class.

Scrapbooking Fun will take place on Saturday, April 9 from 12 to 4 p.m. This drop-in program will teach scrapbooking techniques while offering time for participants to work on their own scrapbooks. Some materials will be provided, however participants are encouraged to bring their own. Free prizes are offered at every meeting. Maree Mundelius Hawkins will share her father's letters and photographs from World War II on Wednesday, April 27 at 6:30 p.m. in the Modesto Library Auditorium. Her father, Lloyd Mundelius, was a Signal Corps

photographer from 1943 to 1946. His military duty covered photographing the battles on Okinawa, the signing of the treaty with Japan, and living in occupied Japan for a year, while working for the 8th Army's commanding general.

The library will celebrate Money Smart Week with the Modesto Money Mavens on Saturday, April 30 at 3 p.m. Participants will learn how to save money on their grocery bills, as well as learn other tips on personal finance. This program is sponsored by the Friends of the Modesto Library.
