Community members are invited to enjoy a variety of free programs at the Modesto Library this June. Multiple Story Times are offered each week:

Wiggle Worms, a special Story Time designed for babies, active toddlers, and adult caregivers takes place on Mondays and Tuesdays at 10:15 and 11:15 a.m. Wiggle Worms features stories, lap bounces, music, dancing, rhythm activities, fingerplays and more.

Preschool Story Time is held on Tuesdays at 6:15 p.m. and Wednesdays at 10:15 a.m. Preschool Story Times feature new and classic picture books, flannel board and puppet stories, fingerplays, music and dancing, for preschoolers ages 3 to 5 and their caregivers, however all ages are welcome.

The Modesto-Stanislaus Poetry Center (MoSt) will offer a free poetry workshop on Saturday, June 9 from 1 to 3 p.m. Stella Beratlis, Modesto's poet laureate, will lead this workshop on "crowd-sourced" poetry, or creating new poetry with friends. All experience levels are welcome.

In celebration of the Summer Reading Challenge, the library will screen movies this summer with travel and exploration themes. This month, community members are invited visit the library on Monday, June 11 at 5 p.m. to experience the story of Mark Watney as he fights for survival on Mars. This film is rated PG-13.

All ages can unwind with a Summer Reading Challenge themed coloring day on Friday, June 15 from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. Colored pencils, crayons, and a variety of travel and space themed designs will be available. Participants will have the opportunity to enroll in this year's Summer Reading Challenge.

Shoppers are invited to visit the Stanislaus County Library's All-Teens Craft Fair on Saturday, June 16, held from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the Modesto Library portico. Local teens will showcase and sell handmade crafts priced at \$10 or less. This event helps teens learn about sales, customer service, and money management.

Teens and adults are invited to test their knowledge at the library's Trivia Night on Monday, June 18 at 5:30 p.m. Participants may compete on their own or as a team, up to a limit of 4 people. Categories include movies/TV, pop culture, and general knowledge.

From 3 to 5 p.m., the library will offer a scavenger hunt, tables will be set aside for the Pokémon Trading Card Game and Nintendo DS players, and lures will be dropped for PokémonGO players.

Comix Club will meet on Thursday, June 28 at 4 p.m. This month, participants are invited to read and join in on discussions, games and activities featuring the comic book series *Avatar: the Last Airbender* by Gene Luen Yang. The Comix Club is suggested for ages 8 and up.

The library, in partnership with the #ModestoROCKS movement, will offer a rock painting program for teens and adults on Friday, June 29 from 1 to 4 p.m. Participants are encouraged to bring their own rocks and drop in to paint rocks with designs and messages intended to inspire kindness in the community.
