On Saturday, April 23 from 1 to 3 p.m. the library will celebrate Día de los niños/ Día de los libros, or Day of the Child/Day of the Book. Children can enjoy a special bilingual Story Time and a craft. Participants will also have the opportunity to visit informational booths from local community agencies. Each child will receive a commemorative activity book and a free new book provided through the Stanislaus READS! initiative.
