November Events at the Oakdale Library

Community members who visit the Oakdale Library this month can take part in free crafts, activities, computer classes and book club discussions.

On Thursday, Nov. 5 at 3:30 p.m. the library will offer a Thankful Wreath Craft for children and teens. The library will provide a variety of colorful paper leaves for participants to adorn with names of people and things for which they are thankful. Participants will then use the paper leaves to create a festive fall wreath.

Free Computer Basics classes will take place on Tuesday, Nov. 10 and 17 at 10:30 a.m. This course offers a basic introduction to computers, including an explanation of the parts of the computer, a tour of Windows, and simple tasks.

Children and their families are invited to LEGO Day on Thursday, Nov. 12 at 3:30 p.m. LEGO play helps develop fine motor skills. Finished LEGO creations will be displayed at the library. Children under the age of 4 are welcome to participate, however they must have direct parental supervision at all times. This program is sponsored by the Oakdale Rotary Club.

The library will host "Wee Move and Play" on Monday, Nov. 16 at 11 a.m. This program features an hour of music, movement, and sensory play for toddlers and preschoolers. Participants will enjoy unstructured play time that promotes creativity, fine motor development, and collaboration.

On Tuesday, Nov. 17, the Oakdale Library Book Club will meet at 11:30 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. This month, each book club member is invited to bring a book to discuss with the group. This month's meeting is designed to be an opportunity for members to discuss their favorite books and inspire others to read them. Light refreshments will be provided.

A Mug Decorating Craft for teens and adults will be held on Wednesday, Nov. 18 at 3:30 p.m. Mugs and decorating supplies will be provided. Finished mugs are hand washable.
