The Nick W. Blom Salida Regional Library will offer free programs for children and adults this January, beginning with "STEAM*: Dinosaurs" on Tuesday, Jan. 5 at 4 p.m., presented by the Great Valley Museum (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) Children can enjoy learning about dinosaurs and prehistoric life.

Children are invited to Stay and Play, Play and Learn after Story Time on Thursdays at 10:30 a.m. Participants can enjoy music, movement, and sensory play.

Free Computer Basics classes will be held on Thursday, Jan. 7 and 21 at 10:30 a.m. This basic introduction to computers will include an explanation of the parts of the computer, a tour of Windows, and simple tasks.

Tech Connect will be held on Saturday, Jan. 9 at 1:30 p.m. Community members are invited to learn how to use the library's apps for electronic resources. Participants will learn how to access the Cloud Library (eBooks), Zinio (electronic magazines), Hoopla (downloadable audiobooks, digital movies and music, and more), and Mango Languages (online language learning).

On Saturday, Jan. 9 at 3:30 p.m., the Modesto Money Mavens will host a free couponing class. Participants will learn how to find bargains and save money.

On Tuesday, Jan. 12 at 10 a.m. the Salida Library Book Club will meet to discuss *Olive Kitteridge* by Elizabeth Strout.
