November Events at the Nick W. Blom Salida Regional Library

Community members can enjoy a variety of free programs at the Nick W. Blom Salida Regional Library this month, beginning with "Animal Adventure" presented by the Great Valley Museum on Tuesday, Nov. 3 at 4 p.m. Children will learn about animal body coverings through hands-on experiences with fur, skin, and shells. The program will compare and contrast different animals, while teaching participants about animals' eating habits and life cycles. This program will include live animals. Animal Adventure is sponsored by the Friends of the Salida Library.

Free Computer Basics classes will take place on Thursday, Nov. 5 and 19 at 10:30 a.m. This course offers a basic introduction to computers, including an explanation of the parts of the computer, a tour of Windows, and simple tasks.
