Call to Order: Jackie called the meeting to order at 6:30.

Approval of the Minutes: Pat P. moved and Barbara seconded her motion that the minutes of the March meeting be approved. Unanimous. Michael thanked Sabra for stepping in for him.

President's Report: Jackie announced that FOTPL had received an anonymous \$100 gift. It was decided that the annual meeting should be combined with the board meeting on 7 June, beginning at 6:30. Meanwhile, Susan Lilly has requested help funding the free books for kids at the Stanislaus County Fair. Carmen moved that we donate \$200, the same amount we donated last year. Mike seconded the motion. Dieter suggested we raise it to \$300. Carmen asked that her motion be so amended. Passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Linda reported income of \$338.35 and expenses of \$812 for the month of March, leaving a checkbook balance of \$16,963.46. The Gallison Fund CD remains at \$6881.03. Our CD also remains at \$7345.23. The Library Fund money market account made a whopping 59¢, bringing our total to \$14,868.19. The two Library Building Fund CDs remain at \$25,195.29 and \$30,000. The combined library funds come to \$70,063.48.

Membership Chair's Report: Mike reported that there was only one new individual membership received in March. The current tally stands at 42 life memberships, 76 individual memberships and 23 family memberships for a grand total of 141.

Report from the Foundation: Pat P. announced that among the Shining Star awards was a member of the FOTPL, Trudy DeGroot of Patterson; Trudy always helps at our book sale and is involved with the Friends of the Patterson Library. She also announced that Hanna Renning will receive the coveted Joan Patterson Stellar Achievement Award. Congratulations to both! Concetta's?
