• The Volunteers in Patrol (VIPs) from the Turlock Police Department once again helped to create a calm and pleasant atmosphere by exercising crowd control at our Members Only Night.

- We had excellent coverage by the *Turlock Journal*, as well as information in the *Modesto Bee*.
- Some books remaining at the end of the sale were picked up by "Friends" from Modesto for their sale in early May. Volunteers and employees of the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department took away hundreds of paperbacks to put in their new jail library. The remainder were packed up into waiting boxes by a large



crew of our members and community volunteers (e.g., Key Club). Again, this year a Stockton group that supports a new library for the Ghana Academy of Music and Art (GHAMA) took away all remaining books.



- The First United Methodist Church was unstinting in its hospitality, as always.
- The book sale is truly a team effort, involving mostly members, but also some others who wish the library well. More than eighty volunteers of all ages, from ten to eighty plus, worked together seamlessly and with enthusiasm.
