- Jack William's committee continued the project to help make library cards are available to all the school children in Turlock. The committee tries to work with three elementary schools each year.

- The Book Bin committee is still successful operating the space at Ritzy Rags
- The new sign for the front of the library was installed thanks to Harrison Gibbs.

- Library beginning a new fiscal year
- Due to economy part-time employees have reduced hours
- Turlock Library now has a new full-time staff member and two part-time staff members, one speaks Spanish.
- Library catalog is now on-line
- County now has a Virtual reference Library
- Under 12 Summer reading program has 850 hours of reading
- Teen Summer reading program plans on over 450 hours of reading
- Turlock Library budget will be similar to last year
- Turlock FOL thanked for all the new materials we purchased last year
- Redevelopment Committee be organized by Vito Chiesa, Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors, District 2 as a result of the study we funded a committee will be established to work on having a library expansion plan ready if and when monies become available.
